

CODE OF CONDUCT FOR STUDENTS

The following are the acts and conducts which amount to forbidden practices:-

- 1. Absence from classes without permission of the Teacher/Vice-Principal /Principal.
- 2. Misbehaviour towards teacher/s or any other employee of the school.
- 3. Disobeying lawful orders of the Teacher/Vice Principal / Principal
- 4. Intentional disturbance of class.
- 5. Bullying/Rowdyism and rude behaviour.
- 6. Eve-teasing/misbehaviour towards girl-students.
- 7. Bringing unauthorized people/articles inside the school.
- 8. Indulging in acts of moral turpitude.
- 9. Smoking /Chewing Gutkha Pan/ Khaini etc.
- 10. Use of drugs or intoxicant (except on prescription by a Registered Medical Practitioner).
- 11. Any form of gambling.
- 12. Theft/pilferage of school/students' property.
- 13. Disfiguring or otherwise damaging any school property.
- 14. Spitting in or near the school building except where the spittoons are provided by the school.
- 15. Use of violence in any form.
- 16. Casteism, Communalism or practice of untouchability.
- 17. Propagating a strike/disruption of classes.
- 18. Association with banned organizations.
- 19. Any conduct unbecoming of a student.

All these above acts of misconduct are the forbidden practices. In the above acts of misconduct, Principal/HOS shall take suitable action as per observation of the disciplinary committee at school level depending upon the gravity of misconduct, which may include:

- a) Oral/written warning to the students and parents.
- b) Detention during the break for completion of neglected class work.
- c) Suspension from attending classes /school for a specified period.
- d) In case of willful damage to school property recovery of loss through replacement of school property.
- e) Expulsion/rustication from school for students of classes IX to XII in required cases.

GENERAL DIRECTIONS

For Students:

All the students are requested to take care of the following-

- 1. Students arriving late will not be allowed to attend classes.
- Students not following the Covid Appropriate Behaviour will not be allowed to attend classes.
- 3. A day in the Vidyalaya commences with morning assembly followed by shlokocharan. All students must join the same.
- 4. All students are requested to be well groomed, with properly trimmed hair, nails and clean uniform.
- 5. All students must clearly mention their name, class and section on their belongings.
- 6. Students are requested not to use Vidyalaya premises after school hours without the permission of the Principal.
- Student members of the Prefectorial Board must wear their badges every day.
- Students are requested not to collect any fee or any other amount from other students.
- 9. Respect and care of the School property is the duty of every student. Students are requested not to damage or misuse the belongings of other students. Any damages done should be reported at once to the Class Teacher/Principal which will be made good by the concerned Student.
- Students should not bring comics/ periodicals, crackers, explosives or any other objectionable content & article to school.
- 11. Students are advised not to be bring any valuables to school. School is not responsible in case of their loss or damage.
- 12. No gifts can be distributed among the students on birthdays. Moreover the student must come to school in school uniform only.
- 13. Students are requested not to whistle or shout in the school premises and maintain the order and decorum befitting the occasion.
- 14. The students are strictly forbidden to leave the school premises during the regular school hours without the permission of the Principal. Parent/Guardian should not request for short leave as it will not be entertained.

- 15. Every student must be regular in attending classes. Students having less than 75% of the total attendance may not be allowed to appear for the annual examination.
- For a leave of absence or in case of sickness a medical certificate must be sent.
- 17. For long absence prior permission is needed. The name of the student who remains absent for six consecutive days without proper sanction or information will be struck off the rolls without intimation.
- 18. A student suffering from any infections or contagious disease should observe the period of quarantine as prescribed by the doctor and on return must produce a Fitness Certificate permitting him/her to attend classes.
- 19. Students are requested not to drive any vehicle to school.
- 20. Boys are not permitted to -
 - Sport long hair and a beard
 - Colour their hair or have spikes
 - Accessorize themselves with studs, rings, kadas etc
 - Wear expensive watches or tattoo
 - ➤ Wear low waist narrow trousers
 - Wear shoes other than prescribed by the school.
- 21. Girls are not permitted to-
 - Apply henna on hands.
 - Colour their hair.
 - Wear accessories/tattoo
 - Wear danglers/ear rings other than simple studs.
 - ➤ Untie hair if long.
 - > Have long nails and apply any nail paint/nail art.

For Parents,

Education is a shared commitment between dedicated teachers and enthusiastic parents. Both the school and parents have 'Child' as the pivot of their relationship. Hence we solicit your co-operation in the school's endeavours to develop the child into a disciplined, proactive youth with integrity and compassion.

Some points are worth noting. You are requested to-

- 1. Furnish medical information of your ward in the beginning of the session.
- 2. Attend PTM held on the last Saturday of every month between 8.30 am to 11.00 am regularly.
- 3. Check your ward's notebooks of all subjects regularly.
- 4. Check your ward's school bag regularly.
- 5. Pay attention to any messages/circulars shared by school or teacher.
- 6. Make sure your ward is well groomed with proper haircut, neatly combed hair, neatly clipped nails, clean & ironed uniform and polished shoes.
- 7. Ensure that your ward has breakfast and reaches school on time.
- 8. Ensure that your ward wears a mask and carries a hand sanitizer.
- 9. Send home cooked, nutritious meal for lunch, pack the lunch properly along with a table cloth and a napkin.
- 10. Ensure that your ward does not reach school before 8.00 a.m. and departs from school later than 2:30 p.m.
- 11. Ensure that your ward Commutes in a safe vehicle meeting all the safety norms. You are requested to check and verify the credentials of the driver and vehicle hired by you. It should confirm to the provision of Delhi Motor Vehicle Rules, 1993 and have an authorised person in it. The related information must be intimated to school. The school shall be grateful if only safe vehicles having authorised LPG/CNG kits registered under DL-IK series are engaged by you for the transportation of your child to school.
- 12. Be appropriately dressed in formals and carry the parents ID-Card while visiting the school.
- 13. Attend all the online and offline sessions specially organized for you for the benefit of your ward.
- Access the web portal (Campus care) for assignments and online fee payment.

- 15. Ensure that your ward doesn't carry any expensive items to the school such as mobile phone, laptop, jewellery etc.
- Inform the school in writing of any change in residential address, contact number etc.
- 17. Refrain yourself from making negative remarks about teachers at home so that children do not lose respect for their mentors.
- 18. Parents may meet the Principal/Vice Principal on Tuesday, Thursday, Saturday between 9.00 am to 10.30 am.
- 19. Fee is payable monthly or quarterly by 10th of first month of each quarter. In case fee is not paid on time, Rs. 10/- per day will be charged as fine. If fees is not paid, name of the student will be struck of the rolls. The student will be granted readmission only at the discretion of the Vidyalaya authorities & after the payment of late fee fine along with readmission charges.

20. Withdrawal

For the withdrawal of a student, application in writing must be submitted till the last date of the month failing which the fee for the next month will be charged.

Transfer Certificate or withdrawal is not issued until all dues with the School are settled.


