Sarvodaya Bal Vidyalaya, Ring Road, Lajpat Nagar. Ms. Manisha Kumar (TGT SCIENCE) from our Vidyalaya attended the workshop.

Through the puppetry workshop teachers were equipped with the art of making and manipulating glove puppets, preparation of puppets out of recycling eco-friendly waste materials and using this art form for creating awareness on plastics through puppet show.

On 9th June, 2023 Delhi State Tide Turners Plastic Challenge Summit 2023 was also organised to recognise excellence and award 194 champion schools who successfully completed all the three levels of the TTPC.
